

## **HLTAID012 Provide First Aid in An Education and Care Setting**

# **Course Description**

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to provide a first aid response to infants and children in line with first aid guidelines determined by the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) and other Australian national peak clinical bodies.

This unit applies to a range of workers within an education and care setting who are required to respond to a first aid emergency, including asthma and anaphylactic emergency. This includes early childhood workers and educators who work with school age children in outside school hours care and vacation programs.

You will gain the knowledge and confidence to perform CPR on an adult, child and infant, with compression and ventilation skills. You will also obtain the knowledge and skills to appropriately respond to casualties that have asthma, anaphylaxis, non-life threatening bleeding, choking, envenomation, fractures, dislocations, sprains, strains, minor wounds, nose bleeds and shock.

This course meets the regulatory requirements as stipulated by the Australian Children's Education and Care Authority.

## **Entry Requirements**

There are no formal prerequisites required for you to enrol in this course, however a sound understanding of the English language is a must.

# **Physical Fitness Requirements**

You will be physical fitness to perform at least 2 minutes uninterrupted single CPR (5 cycle of both compressions and ventilations) on a resuscitation manikin on the floor and general manual handling activities.

#### **Course Duration**

You will expect to complete this course within 20 hour, which combined 9 hours face to face delivery & assessment and 11 hours self-paced pre-course MCQs.

## **Assessment Methods**

- Practical demonstration of CPR skills in various simulated scenarios
- Multiple choice assessment questions
- Incident report writing

**Notes:** The Safe Work Australia First Aid in the Workplace Model Code of Practice requires employers to ensure that their nominated first aiders attend training on a regular basis to ensure currency.

The Code of Practice recommends that refresher training in CPR should be completed annually (12 months) and first aid qualifications should be renewed every three (3) years.

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
